Know Your Neighbor



Joe D'Agostino has been a resident of Tippecanoe since 1988 and is about to celebrate his 95th birthday.

So this month we'll find out a little about Joe and how he ended up here.

Joe was born in Hoboken NJ on November 15, 1922. He was one of 5 children. Joe went to

Catholic school in his early years but graduated from public high school. After graduation he worked in a factory making furniture. He enlisted in the Marines in 1942 and was an airplane mechanic stationed in Vella Lavella in the South Pacific. He was discharged in 1946.

While in service, and on leave he went to Schenectady NY to visit relatives. There he met the woman who would become his wife. He says that it was the dress uniform that won her over. They courted from afar. But, when Joe returned, one month later in June of 46 they got married. They lived in Hoboken NJ. Joe worked for a drugstore. Then after birth of their first child they moved back to Schenectady NY. Joe took a job with GE as a forklift driver in the stockroom. He gradually moved up and finished his career as a Quality Control Inspector in Steam Turbine. Joe was active in the VFW and local politics.

Joe retired from GE in 1984 after 31 years taking an early retirement to take care of his ailing wife who was suffering from colon cancer. After her death in 1987, Joe felt he needed to make some changes.

So, in 1988 having family down in Sarasota, FL, Joe pulled up stakes and moved. He bought a villa in Lake Tippecanoe and lived on Mohican Trail. Through others he found out that Helen Tirella who lived on Tippecanoe Trail was widowed like him. He proceeded to pursue Helen and they became a couple. In October of 1990 they married and Joe moved into Helen's place. Life was great now. They enjoyed many things together. They were active in our community. They enjoyed traveling and went on 21 cruises in their 22 years of marriage.

In April of 2013 Helen passed away unexpectantly. Joe had a hard time bouncing back. But with the friends here at Tippecanoe he has stayed active and enjoys playing cards on Monday night and poker on Thursday night. He also enjoys Bingo.

Joe just came back from an Honor Flight to Washington, DC which was on his bucket list. He's looking forward to celebrating his 95th birthday in November. Joe has 3 children, 6 grandchildren and 9 great grandchildren.

He attributes his long life to moving here to Florida and maintaining a balanced life style.
