**Grounds:** I see a lot of work being done on three foot areas. Good job by all to make Lake Tippy look good. The mulching of common areas is complete. Randy and Russ will be doing pruning and edging and general grounds clean-up, when not mowing. The tree service will be here in February to finish the trimming and dead branch cutting. The fences will be repaired in the next few weeks. We will be sweeping the roads every three months to help keep our road drains clean.

#### **Finance**

Despite \$10,000 in storm damage, we finalized our 2017 year with a \$50,000 surplus (subject to yearend adjustments). We met with Lighthouse to prioritize our spending for 2018. On the plus side, we may only need one new roof this year, however on the negative, three of buildings need extensive exterior renovation. We will be using some of our reserves for this.

In 2017, we upgraded our water supply by reopening an unused well and updating standby generators. We also identified the need for a generator for our sewage treatment plant for extended outages. Because it is close to the Clubhouse, we may be able to extend the power to it as well. This will provide an air conditioned lighted space with a kitchen and WIFI for long power outages. We are exploring costs and feasibility for this major project. Our HOA fees will not increase this year.
